



Coverage for OTC At-Home COVID-19 Tests Through the IATSE National Health and Welfare Fund

As previously announced, group health plans are required to cover over-the-counter (OTC) at-home COVID-19 tests purchased on or after January 15, 2022, limited to 8 per month per covered individual, without participant cost-sharing, preauthorization, or medical management, during the public health emergency. The IATSE National Health & Welfare Fund's prescription drug benefit manager (CVS) provides this coverage for the Fund participants. You may submit claims to CVS for reimbursement (for purchased tests) through the Caremark.com portal.

As of April 25, 2022, reimbursement is limited to \$12 per test (or the cost of the test, if lower). You may also obtain tests at participating CVS pharmacies at no up-front cost to you. This option is available only at CVS pharmacies (not including those at Target and Schnucks stores). As of April 25, you can order tests for direct shipping to you from the CVS website or CVS mobile app. Visit www.caremark.com/covid19-otc for more information.

Please also be reminded that the federal government will give each household 8 free at home COVID-19 tests (two sets of 4 tests). You can order them now at <https://www.covidtests.gov/>.
